Lesson Plan

Positive Posters

Grade Level: Kindergarten

Materials Needed:

- Posters for each student
- Markers/Crayons

Possible Books for Introduction:

1. The Land of Many Colors, by The Klamath County YMCA Family Preschool
2. For Every Child a Better World, by Bruce McNally/United Nations
3. Wherever You Are, by Mem Fox

Suggestion: This project can coincide with Martin Luther King week.

Procedure:

1. Read one or more of the books listed above. Discuss how it is up to us to make the world a better place.
2. On chart paper, write down the children's ideas of what we can do ...
* at home * at school * in our town * in the world
3. Through this process, ask how we can let people know our ideas. (letters, signs, etc. will probably come up.)
4. Have the students make posters with their personal best illustration of how they can make a difference.
5. Deliver the posters to some community facility, such as the local library, post office or city hall.
6. If desired, contact the local newspaper for coverage. The kids love it!
7. Local frame shops often donate a few frames so a few posters can hang in the school!
